Wow!! Here's a spectacular first. Kit is a guitarist and singer hailing from the Southwest of England. You might have encountered him through his work with Sheelanagig and his duo with Aaron Catlow, but he's also collaborated with the likes of Grammy-nominated Yola, Seth Lakeman, Jools Holland, and Roni Size! His contributions to several critically acclaimed albums have cemented his place as one of the finest musicians on the UK folk scene. Known for combining outstanding musicianship with deeply emotive performances, Kit brings a unique energy and authenticity to the stage. His live shows are a rich tapestry of traditional music from the British Isles—particularly the heritage of his native South West of England—interwoven with his own compelling compositions. Don't miss this.

Monday December 8th - FANTASY ORCHESTRA RECORDER ENSEMBLE (tickets £6)

Jan/Jon/JOW is a fabulously unusual composite beast: a seamless weave of uncategorisable acoustic music and lyrical, vivid & poignant words. The latter come from two contrasting poetic voices: Herefordshire-born/Bristol-based Jan Edwards, and Bath-based writer Jon Hamp, both of whom are launching new publications at this event. Music comes from JOW, the cello & trumpet duo of James Gow and Pete Judge, whose music skitters between jazz, folk and classical chamber music to enthralling effect.

Thurs December 11th - CIRENNE & WISP (tickets £10)

Double-bill of insanely talented young Bristol-based bands, both making their El Rincón debut. Cirenne is the brilliantly-unusual trumpet & violin duo of Celeste Cantor-Stephens & Caelia Lunniss (from Spindle Ensemble etc), playing earthy, spacey, experimental, Klezmer-tinged music, and playing it extremely well indeed. They'll be featuring material from their new EP. Wisp is an even newer project, a folk-jazz trio in which Celeste is joined by Alex Heane (guitar) & Charlotte West (mandolin). What a great line-up. New music at its best.

Saturday December 13th - <u>EYEBROW</u>

Oooh. Here's an early Xmas present, and a Saturday 'especial' to boot. Cult ambient-jazz-minimalist duo Eyebrow squeeze a tiny drumkit, a trumpet, and a plank-load of effects pedals onto the famous fun-size yellow stage by El Rincon's front window, and proceed to unfurl music of strangely cinematic beauty. And this is their only 2025 performance anywhere in the world!! Expect a retrospective set from their 7 album releases, plus brand new material

from their just-recorded 8th! "Bristol's answer to Nordic Noir, the spare precision of drumkit paired with haunting FX-mutated trumpet echoing back from a cliff-bound fjord has an ageless simplicity that belies how subtle and clever the music is" (Bristol 24/7).
